

# Steve Meltzer chip carving class required supplies

- Pfeil Swiss made or Wayne Barton chip carving knife.
- Your finest sharpening stone (just in case)
- Leather strop and fine compound
- Basswood  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 8" x 8" – The actual carving will be 6" diameter. The 8" size is a buffer.
- Strong magnifying glasses to wear.
- 3M super 77 spray to glue your pattern down at least one week before class (spray the wood not the paper – use a good amount of glue, but don't flood it).
- Anything you think you might need to make yourself comfortable – like gloves. Folding chair to sit at or stool for the workbench.
- Small bench hook to be used on a bench or on your lap.

Sand surface to 220 grit before applying pattern!!!!
